Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the office of the COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT - ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT, City of Kelso, 203 South Pacific Ave., Suite 205, Kelso, WA 98626 up to **10:00 am Wednesday, June 24, 2015**, and immediately thereafter will be publicly opened and read. Bids not received by **10:00 a.m.** will not be considered. Bids submitted by facsimile machine will not be accepted.

The proposed work shall be for the furnishing of all labor, equipment, materials and supervision for construction of the following:

Description of Work

The project consists of the construction of approximately 1,220 linear feet of 12-inch ductile iron waterline, 20 linear feet of 10-inch ductile iron waterline, 60 linear feet of 8-inch ductile iron waterline, 35 water services, 3 fire hydrant assemblies, and miscellaneous appurtenances. The project also consists of the construction of approximately 1,050 linear feet of 12-inch PVC sanitary sewer pipe, 440 linear feet of 8-inch PVC sanitary sewer pipe, 1,150 linear feet of 6-inch PVC sanitary sewer pipe (side sewers), 240 linear feet of 8-inch PVC storm sewer pipe, eight (8) 48-inch manholes, 2 precast catch basins, connection of the sanitary and storm sewer pipe to new and existing manholes, and the connection of new side sewers in the public right-of-way to existing private side sewers with testing tees and cleanouts at the property line, and all required appurtenances. Restoration will include approximately 1,300 feet of road reconstruction as well as associated concrete curb and gutter, driveways and sidewalks.

Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish a satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Kelso.

accept any bid for the project which appears to serve the best interest of the City.
