Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the office of the COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT-ENGINEERING DIVISION, City of Kelso, 203 S. Pacific Ave., Suite 205, Kelso, WA 98626 up to **10:00 am Tuesday, July 30, 2013**, and immediately thereafter will be publicly opened and read.

The proposed work shall be for the furnishing of all labor, equipment, materials, and supervision for construction of the following:

Description of Work

The project consists of the construction of approximately 1,150 linear feet of 12-inch PVC sanitary sewer pipe, 633 linear feet of 8-inch sanitary sewer pipe, 1,600 linear feet of 6-inch sewer pipe (side sewers), 11 manholes, connection of the sanitary sewer pipe to new and existing manholes, and the connection of new side sewers in the public right-of-way to existing private side sewers with testing tee at the property line, and all required appurtenances. All surface features disturbed in construction shall be restored to original condition or better.

A brief summary of each of the project areas follows:

1. Harris St.: Approximately 626 ft., 12-inch sewer line, 4 manholes, 21 side sewers.
2. Ayers St.: Approximately 246 ft., 12-inch sewer line, 633 ft., 8-inch sewer line, 3 manholes, 26 side sewers.
3. 7th Ave.: approximately 277 ft., 12-inch sewer line, 4 manholes, 7 side sewers.

Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish a satisfactory performance bond within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Kelso.
