COUNCIL BUSINESS:

Grant Offer for FAA Airport Improvement Program: Upon motion by Councilmember Futcher, seconded by Councilmember Karnofski, 'Approve the FAA Grant Offer and allow the City Manager to enter into a contract with FAA for FAA AIP Project 3-53-0034-019-2019'. Airport Manager Chris Paolini briefed the Council on the funding assistance for the project. Motion passed, all voting yes.

Contract Award – Runway Maintenance Project Management and Inspection Service: Upon motion by Councilmember Hill, seconded by Councilmember Karnofski, 'Authorize the City Manager to enter into contract with Century West Engineering for \$57,417.70.' Motion passed, all voting yes.

Contract Award - Runway Maintenance Project Construction Phase: Upon motion by Councilmember Futcher, seconded by Councilmember McAllister, 'Authorize the City Manager to enter into contract with Clark & Son's Excavating, Inc. for \$599,273.97.' Motion passed, all voting yes.

EXECUTIVE SESSION:
